## International Study Travel Fund 2015-16 Application

The International Study Travel Fund provides up to \$5,000 towards the cost of the Seminary's annual summer travel courses. For the 2015-16 year, the trip will be to Israel and will be led by Dr. Hélène Dallaire and Professor Elodie Emig. For more information on the trip itself, please contact these professors.

It is the belief of the donor of this fund that those who are called to preach/teach scripture can be better equipped for this ministry if they are afforded the opportunity to visit various sites where biblical events occurred. Therefore, only full-time students in the second or third year of either the MA Biblical Studies (NT or OT) or Master of Divinity programs will be eligible. Students must also demonstrate financial need (via the FAFSA) and be in good academic standing.

To apply, students must submit this application form along with a **one page essay** to the Financial Aid Office ([financialaid@denverseminary.edu](mailto:financialaid@denverseminary.edu)) stating how a trip to Israel would benefit their future ministries. Applicants must also have a completed **15-16 FAFSA** on file ([www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov)). The FAFSA can take up to 4 days after completion to be sent to our office, so students who haven't yet done this step should submit it as soon as possible. The application deadline for these requirements is **noon on Friday, October 30th.**
